

Directions to:

Plymouth Bridge Club/Plymouth Chess Club
1 Moor View Terrace, Mutley Plain, Plymouth PL4 7EB

(The venue is less than a mile from the A38)

There is a pay and display Car Park (two minutes walk to the venue) situated over the railway line, but there will be **FREE** parking in side roads (less than five minutes walk to the venue) off Mutley Plain.

For Sat Navs use PL4 6QJ (Seaton Avenue) for free parking.

(For the pay and display car park use PL4 6QG)

Exit the **A38** at the Manadon Junction, signposted (Tavistock / Airport / Hospital / City Centre / B3250 Mutley)

Take the exit onto **B3250 Mutley / City Centre**.

Continue on the **B3250** until you reach Mutley Plain (Shops on both sides of road and central reservation has railings on it).

At first set of traffic lights (Hyde Park pub is on your right) continue forward **slowly** in outside lane.

At the second set of traffic lights **turn right** into Ford Park Road (between Plainfun and the Co-operative Food shop) and then **turn immediately left** (between Perillas Fish & Chip shop and Trobridges Solicitors) into the back lane.

At end of lane **turn right** into Seaton Avenue and park car.

If there are no spaces in Seaton Avenue then at the bottom of the avenue **turn left** into Pentille Road as there should be spaces there. If no spaces **turn right** into Dale Road. The old Royal Eye Infirmary building is on your left hand side. Drive right around it keeping it on your left hand side and you will come into Apsley Road. There should be car parking spaces here. The railway line is on your right hand side.

Walk back up to Mutley Plain and cross over to the other side by way of the pedestrian controlled traffic lights.

Turn into **Moor View Terrace**, between the Fortescue Pub and Papa John's Pizza.

The **Plymouth Bridge Club** is the last building on the right hand side.

- ECF Rapidplay Grading Lists (July 2019) will be used to determine seeding. The current FIDE Laws of Chess will apply.
- Seeded Swiss pairings will be made by Controllers using ECF Rules or computer programs based on ECF or comparable rules. Pairings between members of the same family or club etc. will be avoided, if possible, at the sole discretion of the Controller.
- If a player qualifies for more than one cash prize, he/she shall be paid the higher amount and the Congress Director will decide how most fairly any balance shall be re-distributed, shortly after the end of the Congress.
- Congress equipment may not be removed from the playing area.
- Smoking is not permitted on the premises. Mobile Phones must be switched off.
- Food and drink must not be brought into the Plymouth Bridge Club for consumption on the premises.
- Unless informed otherwise the organizers may use photos taken at the event for publicity.
- Players agree to abide by the decisions of the Controllers and accept that in all matters relating to the congress the decisions of the organisers are final.
