## HOW TO GET TO THE CONGRESS

Leave the A35 at the Stadium roundabout and join the A354 following signs to Weymouth. As you exit the A354 at the Manor roundabout (Morrisons superstore) take the first left onto Dorchester Road. Continue ahead for about 2/3 of a mile. Hotel Rembrandt is located on the left hand side.

Weymouth's train station is 0.6miles from the venue and around a 12minute walk or short taxi ride.
