Prizes for ungraded players will be at the discretion of the congress committee.*

Please indicate if you have any impairment which requires special circumstances or remedial actions which need to be taken.

The congress committee reserves the right to refuse entry and to transfer competitors to other sections and to cancel or split any section at their discretion. If a player has not arrived for their game within 30 minutes of the start time, the player will be defaulted, and the controllers may re-pair games.

Players must abide by the FIDE laws of chess and any decisions made by the controllers in interpretation of the Laws are final.

Entries will be accepted up to MIDDAY on Wednesday 22nd May (or when maximum comfortable capacity has been reached) only if the entry fee has been paid on or before Midday as at Thursday 23rd May 2024
