

## CAMBORNE & WEST CORNWALL CHESS CLUB

### GRAND PRIX 2023/24

#### RULES

- 1 The Camborne Grand Prix ("the competition") will run from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 to 31<sup>st</sup> May 2024.
- 2 The competition will include the evening blitz and rapid play tournaments played at the Camborne Chess Club ("the club"), together with the club championship.
- 3 The competition is open to all members of the club.
- 4 Points will be scored in the following manner:
  - a) A player's score for any event (the "event score") shall be calculated using the formula "pw" where "p" is the player's percentage score, "w" is the multiple assigned to the event under rule 3(c).
  - b) The value of "w" shall be determined as follows:
    - 1 for blitz events.
    - 2 for rapid play events.
    - 3 for the club championship.
  - c) A player's total event score for the competition shall be the sum of his or her five highest event.
  - d) A player's bonus score for the whole competition shall be calculated using the formula "nk" where "n" shall be the number of events completed and the value of "k" shall be 20.
  - e) A player's total score for the competition shall be the sum of c) and d).
- 5 A number of cash prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the competition as follows:
  - £25 and £15 to two highest scoring players rated over 1750.
  - £25 and £15 to two highest scoring players rated over between 1400 and 1749.
  - £25 and £15 to two highest scoring players rated below 1400.
  - £10 to the overall winner of the competition.
  - £10 to the highest placed junior.

  - a) For all purposes relating to the competition the grades to be used shall be the September 2023 list of standard play grades as published by the ECF. These grades will apply throughout the season.
  - b) If a player has no published grade, the controller shall make such decision as he sees fit in the interests of the fair running of the competition.
- 7 All games played in this competition will be submitted for inclusion in the appropriate ECF rating List.
- 11 The controller will be responsible for ensuring that results and current standings are publicised as soon as possible after each event.
